2018 OBPC OREGON PRIMARY ELECTION CANDIDATE ENDORSEMENTS April 8, 2018

On April 6-8, 2018, the Oregon Black Political Convention (OBPC) met at the Crowne Plaza Portland Convention Center, 1441 NE 2nd Avenue, Portland, Oregon 97232, and endorsed federal, state and local candidates running for public office in the May 15, 2018 Oregon Primary Election. To receive the OBPC endorsement for the Primary Election, each candidate must receive three-fifth of the votes of the delegates eligible to vote during the endorsement process. The Convention tries to endorse the best major political party candidate for each partisan office. On April 2, 2018, candidates addressed the Convention. Only candidates can address the Convention. On April 8, 2018, the 2018 OBPC delegates endorsed the following partisan and non-partisan candidates.
